Description of Award

This award recognizes an individual or group who contributes or has contributed significantly to the vision and mission of COUPN.

Eligibility

Any individual or group external to COUPN that has made a significant contribution to university nursing education or scholarship, and to the functioning and support of COUPN itself.

Criteria

The individual or group:

- Promotes or supports the advancement of nursing education and /or scholarship.
- Demonstrates a commitment to nursing education or scholarship.
- Is not an active member in a COUPN program.
- Individual candidates may or may not be a Registered Nurse.

Application/Nominations Process

Nominations for this award may be made by a member of a COUPN program. Self-nominations will **not** be accepted. All nominations must include:

 A nomination letter of no more than two pages outlining reason(s) for the nomination that address the aforementioned criteria.

- Two additional letters of support (total).
- Additional, relevant supporting documentation.
- Nomination letters must:
 - o Identify the nominee by name, title, credential, agency as relevant
 - Include nominator and nominee contact information, including email address

Nomination letters and any supporting documentation as noted must be submitted to sfellin@cou.on.ca by your Dean or Director's Office NO LATER THAN end of day Friday, March 24, 2017.
