New Tenure Stream Faculty Contribution Award

Description of Award

This award recognizes the contribution to excellence in teaching by a new tenure stream faculty member in a COUPN School/Faculty.

Eligibility

Faculty members in a COUPN School/Faculty who have commenced their tenure stream appointment within the last two years from the date of nomination, and who have completed or are in the process of completing a doctoral program.

Criteria

- Demonstrated excellence in teaching
- Demonstrated ability to stimulate students to think creatively and critically.
- Demonstrated caring for student learning and student well being.
- Demonstrated enthusiasm for and/or innovation in teaching.
- Demonstrated ability to develop students as nursing professionals.
- Demonstrated ability to motivate students to exceed their own expectations

Application/Nominations Process

Nominations for this award may be made by a faculty member or nursing student in a COUPN program. Self-nominations will **not** be accepted. All nominations must include:

- A nomination letter of no more than three pages presenting a description of the nominee's educational approaches, innovations, pedagogical strategies, and the impact of these on learners as per the aforementioned criteria.
- Two additional letters of support (total) from current students and/or from faculty colleagues.
- Additional, relevant supporting documentation.
- A JPEG image of the nominee for use in the COUPN Awards brochure (if selected)
- Nomination letters must:
 - Identify the nominee by name, title (as relevant) credential, and COUPN School/Faculty
 - Include nominator and nominee contact information, including email address

Nomination letters and any supporting documentation as noted must be submitted to sfellin@cou.on.ca by your Dean or Director's Office NO LATER THAN end of day **Friday, March 24, 2017**.
